



MUSIC HEROES COVID-19 TEACHING POLICY FOR TUTORS & STUDENTS

- STUDENTS AND TUTORS MUST FOLLOW GOVERNMENT ADVICE
- TUTORS SHOULD CARRY OUT LATERAL FLOW TESTS AND REPORT RESULTS TO MUSIC HEROES AND THE SCHOOL THEY ARE VISITING; WHERE REQUESTED BY THE SCHOOL.
- ENSURE ONLY 1 STUDENT IS PRESENT IN A TEACHING ROOM AT ANY TIME
- ENSURE A MINIMUM OF ONE METRE BETWEEN TUTOR AND STUDENT
- TUTORS TO WEAR FACE MASKS DURING LESSONS; Tutors will be provided masks and anti-bacterial wipes for wiping down equipment. Tutors must wipe down all shared surfaces.
- STUDENTS MUST SANITISE THEIR HANDS PRIOR TO ENTERING FOR THEIR LESSON.
- TUTORS TO CARRY OWN HAND SANITISER AND, if possible wash hands between lessons.
- NO SHARING OF GUITARS/UKULELES, PICKS OR DRUMSTICKS. STRINGS TUTORS MUST TALK STUDENTS THROUGH TUNING THEIR OWN INSTRUMENT.
- PIANO TUTORS MAY DEMONSTRATE ON THE KEYBOARD THAT IS IN USE BY THE STUDENT BUT THE STUDENT MUST BE ASKED TO STAND AWAY FROM THE KEYBOARD DURING THE DEMONSTRATION. TUTORS SHOULD TRY TO USE PART OF THE KEYBOARD (SUCH AS THE LOWER OR HIGHER OCTAVES AWAY FROM MIDDLE C) THAT IS NOT IN USE BY THE STUDENT. TUTORS MUST WIPE DOWN THE KEYS PRIOR TO AND AFTER THE DEMONSTRATION BEFORE THE STUDENT RETURNS TO THE KEYBOARD
- STUDENTS SHOULD NOT ENTER THE TEACHING ROOM FOR THEIR LESSON UNTIL THE PREVIOUS STUDENT HAS VACATED AND THE TUTOR HAS COMMUNICATED TO THEM THAT THEY MAY ENTER
- PIANOS/KEYBOARDS ARE TO BE WIPED DOWN BETWEEN STUDENTS.
- TUTORS SHOULD NOT HANDLE STUDENT'S BOOKS
- DRUMS STUDENTS MUST USE THEIR OWN STICKS
- IF POSSIBLE ALLOW ADEQUATE VENTILATION BY OPENING WINDOWS.
- TUTORS, STUDENTS (AND PARENTS WHERE APPLICABLE) MUST ALSO ADHERE TO ANY RULES SET OUT BY THE TEACHING VENUE
